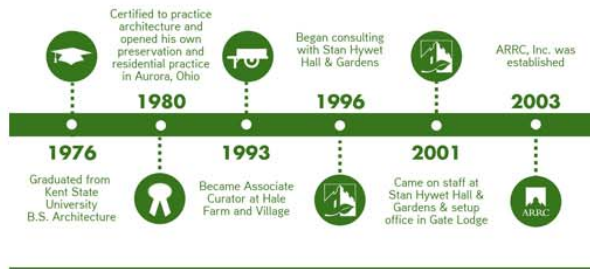

Mark started his restoration career training people to use 19th century hand tools and he hopes to be able to pull those same tools out when he retires.

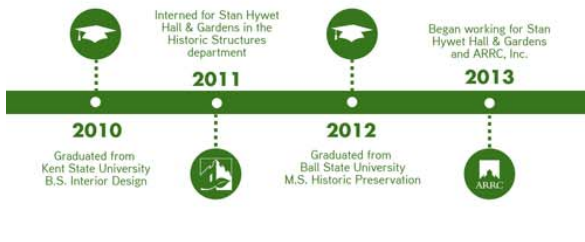
