Position Overview:

The Event Staff & Bartenders are seasonal employese of Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens hired by the President & Executive Director upon the recommendation of the Director of Rentals Services to assist in the operational activity of Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens rentals and events.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Maintain a professional attitude and demonstrate a superior level of hospitality skills when working with the public, volunteers, and staff.
- 2. Must have the ability to assist the Event Manager with all operations of rentals, special events, and meetings.
- 3. Must be able to assist guest with knowledge of Stan Hywet's services and events.
- 4. Ability to set-up and tear-down a room as requested.
- 5. Must be able to greet and transport guests, cross walks, and parking lot activity as needed.
- 6. Ability to drive a tram and certification required.
- 7. Assist rental parties, photographers, and caterers as necessary.
- 8. Provide help to the caterers including changes in set-ups and light custodial duties when required.
- 9. Direct and assist with deliveries and inventory relating to events.
- 10. Assist the Rentals department as needed.
- 11. Knowledge and ability to bartend and manage a cash drawer (must be 21 or older).
- 12. Assist with set-up, ice, and trash as needed.
- 13. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills, and/or abilities required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

1. Must have a valid Ohio Driver's License.



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- 2. Must be 21 years or older if performing bartending responsibilities.
- 3. Ability to interact effectively and professional and demonstrate the highest level of hospitality skills.
- 4. Flexible work schedule.

Education and/or Experience:

- 1. A minimum of a High School diploma, or equivalent, is highly desirable.
- 2. Prior bartending experience a plus.

Usual and Customary Expectations:

- 1. Should expect constant bending, stooping, kneeling, and crouching; and requires full extension of arms, and grasping, holding and pulling in all these positions.
- 2. Should be able to lift and carry approximately 30-50 pounds.
- 3. Ability to work in a standing position 95% of the day.
- 4. Non-traditional hours required.
