## Stan Hywet presents OFF THE VINE: AN EVENING PAIRING OF FOOD AND WINE on JULY 25

July 1, 2025 – Akron, Ohio - Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens presents OFF THE VINE: AN EVENING PAIRING OF FOOD AND WINE from 5:30-8:30 pm on Friday, July 25. Tickets are all-inclusive at \$85 per person for all wine samples, and tapas-style appetizers. Guests must be 21 & over. Designated Driver tickets are \$75 per person.

Guests will receive a souvenir wine tasting glass upon arrival to enjoy samples of dozens of wines and live music in the gardens. Designated drivers will receive a different souvenir glass for enjoying non-alcoholic beverages, including mocktails. All guess must be 21 & over.

Guest parking is on the Great Meadow for easy access to the event.

Wine pours will be complemented by tapas-style appetizers by area caterers, including Acme Fresh Market Catering, A Taste of Excellence, Cleveland Vegan, Nosh Creative Catering, Old Carolina BBQ, and Spice Catering Company. Waxed Crescent Grazing Company will serve cheese samples and Tiffany's Bakery will offer desserts to guests.

Guests can take a chance at the Wine Pull by buying a wrapped bottle of wine (labels are covered) for \$20 per bottle —a good gamble because each bottle is valued at more \$20. A retail wine pop-up shop is open to purchase wines featured at Off the Vine.

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is located at 714 N. Portage Path in Akron, Ohio, and is the former home of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company co-founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Since 1957, it has been a non-profit historic house museum where the public can learn about the cultural, educational, and inspirational riches of one of the most significant achievements in architecture and horticulture to come out of America's Industrial Age. Open April-December, Stan Hywet is the largest historic home in Ohio and the sixth largest in the U.S. Stan Hywet is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and is Akron, Ohio's oldest National Historic Landmark.
