THE 66TH FATHER'S DAY CAR SHOW AT STAN HYWET IS JUNE 16

May 16, 2024 – Akron, Ohio – One of the oldest auto shows in America, the 66th CLASSIC, ANTIQUE, & COLLECTOR CAR SHOW at Stan Hywet is Sunday, June 16, 2024 from 9am - 3pm, and is presented in collaboration with the Ohio Region Classic Car Club of America (ORCCCA).

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is located at 714 N. Portage Path in Akron, Ohio

Four hundred classic, antique, and collector cars and special-interest autos and motorcycles manufactured from 1915 – 1998 will be on view on the Great Meadow. The special feature category is antique Italian automobiles, and the Inner Circle in front of the Manor House features 1940s Full Classics[®]. Antique boats, similar to those owned by the Seiberling family, are also on display.

General admission to the Father's Day Car Show includes a self-guided tour of the Manor House and historic gardens, Corbin Conservatory as well as Playgarden and Homes of Nature play areas. Food vendors selling a variety of lunch items and snacks include The Winking Lizard, Gio's Pizza Lab, Molly's Courtyard Café, Holcomb's Nuts and Kona-Ice.

Car Show tickets may be purchased at stanhywet.org or by calling 330-315-3287. Tickets are \$16 adult; \$8 youth, ages 3-17; free, children 2 and under.

All guest parking for the Father's Day Car Show is off-site with free parking and shuttle service to and from the following nearby parking lots: Five Points Plaza, 634-670 W. Exchange Street; Litchfield Community Learning Center, 470 Castle Boulevard; and Case Community Learning Center, 1420 Garman Road. A limited number of accessible parking spots are available in Stan Hywet's parking lot on a first come, first served basis and with the appropriate state hangtag or license plate.

ABOUT STAN HYWET

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is the former home of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company co-founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Since 1957, it has been a non-profit historic house museum where the public can learn about the cultural, educational, and inspirational riches of one of the most significant achievements in architecture and horticulture to come out of America's Industrial Age. Open April-December, Stan Hywet is the largest historic home in Ohio and the sixth largest in the U.S. Stan Hywet is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and is Akron, Ohio's oldest National Historic Landmark.
