THE STAN HYWET PLANT SALE BEGINS MAY 18

Stan Hywet members may shop one day earlier on May 17

April 25, 2024 – Akron, Ohio –Stan Hywet’s annual **PLANT SALE** begins on May 18 at 10 am in the Courtyard near Molly’s Shop. Plants for sale includes a wide array of perennials, grown from divisions from plants in the historic Great Garden, as well as herbs, cactus and succulents, and annuals — including a large selection of lisianthus. The plant sale ends on June 2.

“Our plant selection includes pollinator plants that feed butterflies, like milkweed, lavender, aster, and bee balm. Guests purchasing plants from Stan Hywet get the healthiest plants around, while also supporting Stan Hywet,” notes Joe Mihalik, Greenhouse Manager.

There is no admission for guests who are shopping at the Plant Sale and/or Molly’s and not taking a tour.

Molly’s is open Tuesday-Sunday (closed Monday) from 10 am-5 pm, and the estate is open for tours from 10 am – 6pm. Last entry to the estate is 4 pm.

Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens is located at 714 N. Portage Path in Akron, Ohio, and is the former home of Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company co-founder F.A. Seiberling and his family. Since 1957, it has been a non-profit historic house museum where the public can learn about the cultural, educational, and inspirational riches of one of the most significant achievements in architecture and horticulture to come out of America’s Industrial Age. Open April-December, Stan Hywet is the largest historic home in Ohio and the sixth largest in the U.S. Stan Hywet is accredited by the American Alliance of Museums and is Akron, Ohio’s oldest National Historic Landmark.
